

Catterick Village Cemetery

Rules and regulations made by the Parish Council of Catterick, North Yorkshire, for the management of Catterick Cemetery.

General

1. The Council reserves the right to close the Cemetery or to limit the entry of persons at any time without notice.
2. Children under the age of 12 will not be allowed in the Cemetery except in the care of a responsible adult.
3. Children should not be allowed to wander or play on or near graves and memorials.
4. No dogs, with the exception of guide dogs, are allowed in the Cemetery.
5. Persons entering the Cemetery do so at their own risk. The Parish Council shall not be held responsible for any injury or damage which may occur to person or property except in the case of personnel injury where it can be proved that the council has been negligent.

Internments

6. All funerals will take place between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 3.30 p.m.
7. No burials will be permitted between 12 a.m. on Saturday and 9.30 a.m. on Monday, except by special arrangement and at double fees
8. The selection of any grave space shall be by the approval of the Council and consistent with their general plans.
9. All fees must be paid at the time of order and before any work is carried out.

Memorial and vases.

10. Shrubs and plants must not be planted on any grave not surrounded by a kerb stone. All permitted memorials and vases must be placed at the head of the grave.
11. Only one vase is permitted per grave
12. No bell glass or glass container of any kind is permitted on any grave.
13. The placing of decorations and adornments, other than flowers, is not permitted and may be removed by the Council.
14. No new kerbs, mounds or footstones will be permitted in any section of the Cemetery
15. No new headstone over 3'6" high or 2' wide will be permitted in any part of the Cemetery.

16. No new head stone which is not constructed in natural materials will be permitted in any section of the Cemetery.
17. Details and drawings of any proposed memorial and inscription thereon must be submitted to the Council for approval. No memorial or inscription shall be placed in the Cemetery without the approval of the Council.
18. Where a grave to be re-opened has a tombstone on, this must be removed and replaced by a qualified person on the responsibility of the owners.
19. When, in the opinion of the Council, a memorial or vase is not maintained in good repair, it shall be removed by the Council.
20. All Communications concerning purchase of grave spaces, internments and memorials should be addressed to the Clerk to Catterick Parish Council.
