4 Annual Report

Cllrs Rafferty and Bannister resigned from the Council during the year and the Chairman, Cllr Campbell, thanked them for the work they have done over the years that they were Councillors. She welcomed two new Councillors, Cllrs O'Connor and Cllr Clarkson to the Parish Council. Cllr Campbell also thanked Cllr Les for his help over the year and the Clerk for her work.

The Chairman then gave a report on activities and events during the past 12 months.

1. The main project of the year was the upgrade to Kings Close Playground installing new swings and a net rotary climber for older children and replacing the multi play station for younger children with a new one. A small toddler slide was also installed on the embankment. A grant of £10,000 from Richmondshire District Council was received to help pay for this. The total project cost £29,500.

2. Extra Christmas lights were bought using £300 given by Cllr Les from his Locality Budget Fund. A switch on was organised again this year by Cllr Young with refreshments donated by the Coop and helped by his wife Val.

3. The village greens, hedges trees and cemetery were maintained throughout the year. A grant of £300 was received from Cllr Les using money from his Locality Budget Fund to help pay for this.
